

2012 OUTLAW PRO MOD PROGRAM



Outlaw Pro Mod will be run at selected special events at Maryland Int'l Raceway. On these events, Pro Mod entries will receive car, driver and three crew credentials free provided the car meets minimum E.T. requirements and has pre-entered the event (pre-entry deadline is 5 days prior to the race). The quickest 8 qualifiers will compete for the posted purse. There will be two qualifying rounds for the Pro Mods at each event.

There will also be a "Pro Mod Shootout" for the next 8 quickest cars (4 car minimum) at each event. The "Shootout" will be run behind the Pro Mod Quick 8 Show to allow what would otherwise be DNQ cars a chance to race.

Entry Rules

- Minimum ET to pre-enter is 6.90
- All IHRA safety rules and requirements in effect
- Northeast Outlaw Pro Mod Association Rules will be used. Go to neoutlawpromods.com to view class rules
- Top Sportsman type cars that run this program only need to meet IHRA T/S safety requirements

Race Procedures

- In first round, lane choice will go to the lower qualifier. In each round thereafter, lane choice will go to the Low ET from the previous round. Courtesy staging is required. Drivers will be permitted to make one shakedown run (time permitting) prior to the first qualifying session. Any cars that DNQ or are eliminated in early rounds are limited to only one shakedown run (time permitting) after the start of eliminations.
- In the event of rain during an event resulting in drying conditions that are not favorable to dry the entire shutdown, the completion of the event may be run on the 1/8 mile. The race director will make this decision, without recourse from any competitor.
- A maximum of one shakedown run is permitted prior to the start of qualifying (time permitting)
- During qualifying the run order will be as follows:
 - First Session by drawing
 - Second Session by previous round ET, slower cars first
- Auto Start Settings: "STAGED" Minimum 0.5 seconds - "STAGED" to Start 0.3 seconds - Total Timeout 7 seconds

2012 OUTLAW PRO MOD EVENT SCHEDULE

FRIDAY - SUNDAY, APRIL 20-22, 2012

Testing will be available from Fri, April 20th through Sun, April 22nd for all Pro Mod cars. On Friday night, there will be two shakedown sessions, on Saturday there will be three qualifying sessions. On Sunday there Quick 8 and Shootout Eliminations plus all DNQ or early round losers can make test runs behind Pro Mod eliminations each round. The weekend's test session is free to all Northeast Club Members and also includes three crew weekend passes. The testing fee for all non-club members is \$100 (plus the cost of admission for any crew). So be sure to join the NEOPMA, it is a GREAT club to be a part of!

Outlaw Pro Mod Purse (guaranteed for an 8 car show)

With additional sponsor help, we would like to add additional purse (100% of any sponsor dollars will go directly into purse)

Winner	\$2,000
Runner-Up	\$1,000
Semis	\$750
1st Round Loser	\$500
Shootout Winner	\$500 (Winner take all)
TOTAL	\$7,000!

All qualifiers must run in eliminations in order to receive payout. In the event that a qualifier cannot make first round due to breakage, the purse will go to the alternate who runs in his place in eliminations. If a qualifier is a "no-show" in eliminations and did not inform race officials in time to put an alternate in, then no purse will be paid for that position.

The next quickest 8 cars will qualify for the Pro Mod Shootout. This will be a heads-up, 3-round race for a \$500 winner take all purse. It will be run just behind the Pro Mod Quick 8. The Pro Mod Shootout will only be run if it has a minimum of 4 cars for first round.
